Phrasal Verb	Translation	Example
Agree with	يتفق مع	<i>I agree with you. I think she deserves the award too.</i>
Apply for	يتقدم بطاب الحصول	<i>I am going to apply for visa next summer.</i>
Bring about	يسبب، يحدث	<i>His laziness brought about his failure in the exam.</i>
Bring up	يربي	<i>Parents should bring up children to respect their teachers.</i>
Break down	يتعطل	<i>I had to take the bus, because my car broke down.</i>
Check in	ينزل في فندق	<i>I will call the hotel. We should check in tomorrow.</i>
Check out	يسجل خروجه من فندق	<i>They packed and checked out of the hotel.</i>
Come up with	يفكر في، يقترح أفكار أو حلول	<i>They had a meeting for 2 hours, but they didn't come up with a solution</i>
Calm down	يهدأ	<i>The police told the lost boy to calm down.</i>
Call for	يناشد	<i>The association calls for children protection.</i>
Carry out	ينفذ خطة، تعليمات، تهديد، أو مهمة ما	<i>The party carried out their threat and left the government.</i>
Come across	يجد بالصدفة	<i>When I was working on the computer, I came across an old photo of me.</i>
Drop in	يزور	<i>I will drop in to see you next summer.</i>
Figure out	يتوصل الى معلومة يستنتج	<i>It took me all the day to figure out how to use this machine.</i>
Fill in	يملأ استمارة، أو فراغا لإكمال جملة او فقرة أو جدول	<i>To apply for the visa, please fill in this form.</i>
Find out	يكشف	<i>When you lose everything, you find out who your friend is.</i>
Give up	يتوقف عن يقطع	<i>The doctor advised him to give up smoking.</i>
Give up	يستسلم	<i>I tried many times without any result. That's why, I gave up.</i>



Go through	يمر بتجربة، ظروف معينة	<i>Peter went through a lot of pain after the accident.</i>
Go ahead	يتابع/يتقدم/يتفضل	<i>Student: I have question. Teacher: Please, go ahead.</i>
Get on with Get along	يتفاهم مع شخص ما	<i>Richard and his sister don't get along.</i>
Hand out	يوزع	<i>He was handing out free tickets for the concert.</i>
Jot down	يسجل نقطا أو ملاحظات	<i>Jot it down before you forget it.</i>
Look after	يعتني	<i>I sorry I didn't come. I had to look after my little brother.</i>
Look down	يحتقر - يستهزئ	<i>He looked down on his friend because he failed the exam.</i>
Look up	يبحث عن معنى كلمة في المنجد	<i>You don't have to look every word up to understand the text.</i>
Look forward to	يتشوق - يتطلع الى	<i>I'm looking forward to hearing from you.</i>
Make up	يخترق كذبة أو عذر /يصطنع	<i>He made up the story to justify his absence.</i>
Pick up	يتعلم بشكل غير ارادي	<i>John picked up some Arabic when he was in Morocco</i>
Put up	يسكن شخصا في البيت	<i>Don't stay in a hotel. We can put you up for a few days.</i>
Put up with	يتحمل	<i>I can't put up with this noisy music.</i>
Put on	يرتدي ملابس	<i>It's cold outside. Put on something warm.</i>
Put out	يخمد حريق	<i>It took a long time to put out the fire.</i>
Run out of	ينفذ	<i>We're running out of time. Hurry up!</i>
Set up	يؤسس	<i>I'm going to set up a business, next year.</i>
Show up	يظهر	<i>I was in the meeting, but you didn't show up.</i>
Stand for	يعود على	<i>HD stands for « High Definition »</i>
Stay up	يسهر	<i>Don't stay up in order to wake up early.</i>
Take off	تقلع الطائرة	<i>The plane took off at 6 p.m.</i>
Take off	يخلع ملابس	<i>He took off his clothes and got into the bath.</i>
Take up	يبدأ هواية/عملا جديدا	<i>The children have taken up tennis and they're really enjoying it.</i>
Turn down	يقلل مستوى الصوت	<i>Could you turn the music down, please?</i>

Turn up

It's news time, can you **turn up** the TV.

Turn on

يشبه

She **takes after** her sister. She looks like her.

Watch out

إحذر

Watch out! That knife is very sharp.
