Direct Speech	Reported Speech
1. « You should have rest » (Advice)	Reporting V. The doctor advised me to have rest Rule Advise + Object + Infinitive (To + Verb)
2."I'm sorry! I come late." (Apology)	Rule Apologize+ Preposition + Gerund (V+ing)
3. " Can you help me" (Request)	Rule She asked me to help her. Ask + Object + Infinitive
4. " Stay home!" (Order)	They ordered me to stay home. Rule Order + Object + Infinitive
5. "Don't go out!" (Order – Negative)	Rule Order + Object + not + Infinitive

Rule Summary Advise + Object + Infinitive (To + Verb) Invite Warn Encourage Order Ask Told (someone) Example: The doctor advised me to have rest. Decide Agree + Infinitive (To + Verb) **Promise** Refuse Example: He decided to start the following day. + Preposition + Gerund (V+ing) Insist **Apologize** (On / For) Example: She **insisted** on helping me. + Gerund (V+ing) Recommend Deny Suggest Example: We suggested watching a film that night. Congratulate + Object + Preposition+ Gerund Blame Accuse (of / for / on) Example: They accused the man of stealing the paint. Admit Decide Agree Deny Insist **Explain** + that + ... Promise Complain Suggest Example: He explained that It hadn't been him.
